This highly practical and hands-on course gives students the opportunity to apply the techniques they learn using real people as their canvas. Working from a dedicated campus in the heart of Perth's CBD, students are taught by our highly experienced, award-winning trainers who also work professionally in the make-up industry themselves.

Should I enrol?

This 12-month course is for anyone who's serious about pursuing a career in creative make-up. You'll learn everything you need to kickstart a career in this glamorous, fast-paced industry.

What will I learn?

The full range of application skills, such as camouflage, liquid latex, special effects, body art, air-brushing and much more – includes:

- Styling wigs and hairpieces;
- Applying specialist make-up for photographic, theatre, period, special effects, film, television and fashion; and
- Working with silicone and latex to create unusual and stunning effects within the entertainment industry.
- Gain practical, real-world experience with the highly accomplished Irish Theatre Players, helping to bring their productions to life through creative make-up.

This qualification will equip you with the necessary skills and expertise to become a special effects make-up artist and to transform individuals and performers into eye-catching characters

How will I learn?

The course is offered on campus in the heart of Perth's CBD for two days a week over a year. Incorporating plenty of hands-on practical experience, you will be taught by a fully qualified and trained theatrical make-up artist with many years' industry experience. Assessments combine written, oral and practical work. You will receive Trainer support throughout your studies.

Student entry requirements

TrainSmart Australia will assess a student's 'academic suitability' to ensure the student has the best chance of success. This is determined by either: The student providing TrainSmart Australia with a copy of an Australian Year 12 certificate; or, the student providing TrainSmart Australia with a copy of Certificate IV qualification (or above); or, the student completing the Core Skills Profile for Adults online assessment passing at or above Exit Level 3 in the Australian Core Skills Framework in both reading and numeracy.

Academic Suitability

In addition to the entry requirements, the College will consider whether the student applying to enrol is academically suited to undertake the course, and demonstrates the capacity to meet the demands of their chosen course. Student academic suitability is determined through a one to one career counselling session where the student is invited to provide details of their previous work history and/or prior education relevant to the course. The student will be advised whether he or she is considered to be academically suited, or alternative study pathways may be offered.

Fee payment options: VET Student Loan* OR upfront payment fully self-funded OR payment plans are available.

VET Student Loans will not be approved for students who do not meet eligibility requirements. VET Student Loan give rise to a HELP debt that continues to be a debt due to the Commonwealth until it is repaid and the VET Student Loan may attract a 20% Government loan fee.
